PERSONAL TAX

P1196 Personal tax round up (31.15 minutes)

Dean Wootten highlights the further announcements that have been made linked to COVID-19, discusses the latest recommendations linked to off-payrolling in the private sector and provides us with a summary of some recent tax cases heard by the Tribunals.

P1197 Finance Bill - Pension changes (14.14 minutes)

Malcolm Greenbaum looks at the changes to the annual allowance tapering calculation and lifetime allowance limit. He concludes by explaining the 'cliff edge' tax effect that made health consultants earning close to the threshold income level reluctant to work extra hours.
