PERSONAL TAX

P1371 Personal tax round up (16.04 minutes)

Dean Wootten takes a look at some recent Tribunal cases looking at areas including an invalid furlough claim, directors' loan write-offs, residency and the use of an agency company.

P1372 Finance Bill 2023 - Pension changes (12.44 minutes)

Ros Martin explains the changes that have been made to both the annual and lifetime allowances and related charges for pensions.
